

Extension Instruction Addendum

Make sure you read and understand these instructions before begining your junstallation

Following are additional steps for installing sills with an extension kit.

1 Cut the extension to the width of the opening, as well as the main sill.

2 Cut the T-Strip to the width of the opening. The length of the T-Strip should match the length of the main sill and the extension.

3 Dry fit the extension, main sill, and

T-Strip in the opening to ensure proper fit before gluing in place.

4 For Standard sills, if the main sill extends past the wall more than you would like, you can rip the main sill to a more desireable depth.

5 Once you have ensured proper fit, apply balls of polyurethan construcion adhesive to the bottom of the sill extension. Apply the adhesive 3 to 6 inches from each end, and 12 inches

apart.

6 Apply a bead of caulk to the window frame where the sill extension will meet.


Firmly insert the sill extension in place, making sure it fits snugly against the window frame. Clean any caulk that


8 Apply balls of adhesive to the remaining original sill area. Apply the adhesive in balls, 3 to 6 inches from each end, and 12 inches from each other.


9 Insert the main sill in place, leaving a small gap for the T-Strip.

Apply a bead of caulk in the gap between the main sill and the sill extension. Insert the T-Strip and push the main sill snugly against the T-Strip and sill extension. Clean off any caulk that gazes out.

11 Apply a bead of caulk in the joints between the sill and the window, and the sill and the drywall. Smooth the caulk with a wet finger.
