

## Wrapping Johnsonite Millwork Bull Nose Corner

## NOTE: Results may vary depending on specific profile selected



- Determine the radius of the bullnose corner
- Select a piece of pvc pipe with the same radius as the bullnose corner
- Utilizing a heat gun, warm the back of the piece of Millwork in the area where the bend will occur
- Warm the piece of Millwork until it begins to soften and the face of the piece becomes warm to the touch
- Wrap the heated Millwork tightly around the pvc pipe
- Insert the Millwork tightly wrapped around the pvc pipe into a bucket of clean, cold water
- After a few seconds, remove the pvc pipe and allow the Millwork to continue to cool
- After 15-20 seconds, remove the Millwork from the water and dry the piece with a clean white cloth
- The Millwork will now conform tightly to the Bullnose corner
